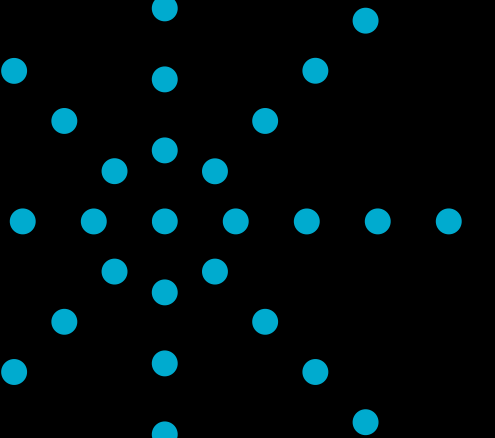

Audition Eligibility

- Students must be aged between 14 and 18 at time of travel (January 9, 2026).
- All students require a chaperone as a 1:1 ratio.
- Each student may bring more than one chaperone from their family.
- Non-USA residents must have a valid passport (or be willing to obtain one).
- Participants must arrange and pay for their own travel to New York City and home from Atlanta.

How to Audition (UK)

1. Students attending the Junior Theatre Festival Europe with their school or academy in Birmingham on May 24 and 25, 2025 are eligible to audition to become an International All-Star.
2. Group directors are required to submit you for an in-person audition. They can only submit 4 students from their group. They must pre-register students to audition through the form distributed via MTI as part of the festival registration.
3. Please see your teacher or group director if you wish to register for an audition.
4. Once your group director has registered you, we will notify you of your allocated group audition time at JTF. You are not required to prepare anything for your audition. Auditions are fast-paced and include learning a short dance routine, 8/16 bars of music, and a short acting side.
5. Auditions will take place during one of the afternoon workshop sessions at JTF Europe. A teaching artists to guide the students through the audition will be provided.
