

INTERNATIONAL ALL-STARS SCHOLARSHIP



Music Theatre International and Travel Gang have partnered to provide a needs-based scholarship for a student based in the UK to join the International All-Stars ensemble. This elite performance group will rehearse in New York City and perform at the Junior Theatre Festival Atlanta in January 2025.

The scholarship is for one student and their chaperone to participate in the program, valued at \$8440 USD.

Scholarship Includes:

- 11 nights Twin share accommodation (New York / Atlanta)
- Flight from NYC to Atlanta as part of the group itinerary
- Private coach transfers listed in the itinerary
- Breakfast each day
- Junior Theatre Festival Atlanta admission
- Tickets to three Broadway musicals
- Broadway masterclass
- Central Park ice-skating, NY City guided tour
- New York rehearsal room hire
- Director, Choreographer and Musical Director
- Admissions for chaperone activities as listed in the itinerary
- Accompanying tour director

Scholarship excludes;

- Travel to New York City
- Travel home from Atlanta hotel
- Travel Insurance
- Travel visas
- Meals other than breakfast
- Spending money and additional activities at your own cost.

Terms and Conditions Apply

Scholarship Eligibility

- Students must be aged between 14 and 18 at time of travel (January 10, 2025).
- Students must be supported by their teacher / theatre educator.
- All students require a chaperone as a 1:1 ratio.
- Each student may bring more than one chaperone from their family but only one is included in the scholarship.
- Non-USA residents must have a valid passport (or be willing to obtain one).
- Participants must arrange and pay for their own travel to New York City and home from Atlanta. This is not included in the scholarship.

How to Audition

1. Make sure your parents read and understand the commitment involved with this programme and that you meet the eligibility criteria above.
2. Create an audition video and upload it to YouTube or Dropbox. Make sure you include the following:
 - Your name, Where you are from, Your school/academy
 - A 32-bar cut of a musical song, with you singing accompanied by piano or track.
 - No acapella singing, please. If you upload your audition video to YouTube, we recommend you make the link 'unlisted' to keep it off the public internet.
