

Audition Eligibility

- Students must be aged between 11 and 18 at time of travel (21/05/2027).
- All students under the age of 16 at the time of travel (21/05/2027) are required to have at least one chaperone registered with the tour. This could be a parent another adult on the tour known to the student.
- Students must meet the Travel Gang terms and conditions. www.travelgang.com.au/terms-conditions
- All successful auditionees and tour participants must hold a valid passport,
 or be willing to arrange one if offered a place on the adventure.

How to Audition

Students attending the Junior Theatre Festival with their school or academy in 2025 are eligible to audition to become an All-Star.

Group directors are required to submit you for an in-person audition. They can only submit 8 students from their group. They must pre-register students to audition through the online portal **HERE**.

Please see your teacher or group director if you wish to register for an audition.

Once your group director has registered you, we will notify you of your allocated group audition time at JTF. You are not required to prepare anything for your audition. Auditions are fast-paced and include learning a short dance routine, 8/16 bars of music, and a short acting side.
